? SUNDAY NIGHT SLAM -- SHOW OPEN

Prestige. Psychology. Pro Wrestling.

The screen is black.

A single heartbeat.

Then another.

A slow fade-in: the Philadelphia skyline at dusk, lights flickering like nerves firing before a fight. The voice of Scott Cooper cuts through -- calm, grounded, carrying the weight of a man who knows tonight matters.

Scott Cooper (V.O.) "Tonight... the landscape of the Superstar Wrestling Federation begins to shift."

Cut to Velvet Empress standing in silhouette, crown lowered, the Women's Championship glinting like a threat. Cut to Miss USA tightening her gloves, jaw set, eyes burning with purpose.

Scott Cooper (V.O.) "A division evolves. A rivalry ignites. And the summer begins with a statement."

A sudden blast of static -- Jimmy V barges into the audio like a meteor.

Jimmy V (V.O.) "SCOTT, I'M TELLING YOU RIGHT NOW -- SOMEBODY IS LEAVING TONIGHT WITH A BROKEN DREAM AND A BRUISED EVERYTHING."

Cut to the "Actual Champion" pacing backstage, title slung over his shoulder with defiant arrogance.

Scott Cooper (V.O.) "And the man who calls himself the Actual Champion... has something to say."

Jimmy V (V.O.) "He's rewriting the rulebook, Scott! He's rewriting HISTORY! I HAVEN'T SLEPT SINCE WEDNESDAY."

A clean, surgical cut -- Valerie Vortex enters like a scalpel.

Valerie Vortex (V.O.) "Tonight is about leverage. Momentum. And the athletes who understand how to control both."

## Sunday Night SLAM: Episode 2

Quick cuts:

Carnival Strongman bending a steel bar

Maniac Mechanic tightening a wrench with malicious intent

Agents of Order marching in formation

Fuego Family lighting a match

Victor Steele shadowboxing with mechanical precision

Leo Maximus roaring under arena lights

Valerie Vortex (V.O.) "Every match tonight affects the rankings. Every ranking affects the summer. Nothing is accidental. Welcome to the road to... CONVERGENCE!"

Then -- silence.

A single spotlight hits the entrance tunnel.

Adam Glory steps into frame, stoic, focused. Shawn FX appears on the opposite side, bouncing on his toes, eyes sharp, ready.

Scott Cooper (V.O.) "Two men. One main event. A collision of legacy and ambition."

Jimmy V (V.O.) "AND I'M SWEATING THROUGH MY SUIT, SCOTT."

Valerie Vortex (V.O.) "This is going to be a tempo war. and an epic battle of wills!"

The SLAMtron explodes to life -- molten blue and silver -- as pyro erupts across the stage in a controlled, elegant cascade.

Scott Cooper (LIVE) "Ladies and gentlemen... welcome to Philadelphia. Welcome to the prestige. Welcome... to SUNDAY NIGHT SLAM."

Jimmy V "BUCKLE UP, AMERICA. HOLD ON TO YOUR BUTTS WORLD!"

Valerie Vortex "Let's begin. There's no turning back now!"

The camera sweeps the roaring crowd as the first graphic hits:

TONIGHT: VELVET EMPRESS vs MISS USA -- WOMEN'S DIVISION SHOWCASE

## Sunday Night SLAM: Episode 2

Fade to ringside.

SLAM begins.

### Velvet Empress vs Miss USA

RING ANNOUNCER (LIVE)

"Ladies and gentlemen, the following contest is scheduled for one fall... and it is for the SWF Women's World Championship!"

Crowd roars.

MISS USA ENTRANCE

Patriotic synth-rock hits. Red, white, and blue strobes sweep the arena.

Miss USA steps onto the stage, cape flowing, jaw set with purpose.

Scott Cooper: Ranked number three in the Power Rankings, Miss USA enters tonight with momentum -- and a mission. She earned this title shot last week after Miss USA defeated Diamond Dana Cortez right here on SLAM. That's no small feat! Cortez is a beast!

Jimmy V: HER MISSION IS TO PUNCH HER TICKET TO CONVERGENCE AND POSSIBLY MY FACE. MAYBE SHE'LL KICK ME IN THE GROIN AND...

Valerie Vortex: Umm... is that even PG? Anyway... Miss USA is explosive, but she must control the timing. If she lets Empress dictate pace, this ends quickly.

Miss USA salutes the crowd, then marches to the ring with intensity.

VELVET EMPRESS ENTRANCE

Lights drop. A single crimson spotlight hits the stage.

A slow, ominous orchestral theme begins.

Velvet Empress emerges, crown lowered, the Women's Championship draped over her shoulder like a decree.

She walks with regal disdain.

## Sunday Night SLAM: Episode 2

Scott Cooper: She calls herself the monarch of ruthlessness -- and tonight, she defends her throne."

Jimmy V: AND SHE SAID SHE'S REDECORATING THE ARENA IN RED VELVET. I'M HIDING UNDER THE DESK.

Valerie Vortex: Jimmy I bet anything you say is written in all caps if this show is ever made into a transcript. Are you ok buddy? How many Red Bulls did you have? "Yes, in terms of this highly anticipated Women's title match No. 1 Contender vs Champion - Velvet is a master of ring control. Watch how she manipulates space. She's impressive."

Empress steps into the ring, raises the title with one hand, and stares down Miss USA.

MATCH BEGINS

DING DING!

OPENING MINUTES (0:00-2:00)

Collar-and-elbow tie-up. Empress forces Miss USA into the corner.

Scott Cooper Velvet Empress establishing dominance early.

Valerie Vortex: She's cutting the ring diagonally -- that's intentional. It limits Miss USA's escape routes.

Miss USA breaks free, hits a quick arm drag, then a dropkick.

Crowd pops.

Jimmy V: THE GOVERNMENT-ISSUED FIRECRACKER IS IGNITING!

MISS USA SHINE (2:00-5:00)

Miss USA hits:

Running lariat

Kip-up

Corner blockbuster

Near fall.

Scott Cooper: Miss USA is fighting like her path to CONVERGENCE depends on it not to mention wearing

gold once again in her illustrious career!"

VALERIE She's increasing tempo -- that's her advantage. I also see Miss USA is wearing her vintage mask tonight. She wore that when she won her first Women's Championship. That's strong motivation.

Jimmy V: Wait. Miss USA is wearing her lucky mask tonight? She's probably wearing it to boost her merch sales. Smart!

Scott Cooper: Jimmy, will you STOP!

EMPRESS HEAT (5:00-9:00)

Empress catches Miss USA mid-springboard -> rope-hung neckbreaker.

Crowd groans.

Empress slows the match to a crawl, working the neck and shoulder.

Valerie Vortex: She's targeting the cervical spine to set up the Red Velvet Guillotine."

Jimmy V: THE EMPRESS IS SUFFOCATING HER LIKE A BAD CREDIT SCORE!

MISS USA COMEBACK (9:00-11:00)

Miss USA counters a suplex -> jawbreaker. Running blockbuster again -> near fall.

Crowd surging.

Scott Cooper: Miss USA is one move away from changing the summer landscape!

Jimmy V: PHILLY IS FOAMING AT THE MOUTH!

FINISH (11:00-12:00)

Miss USA goes for her finisher -- Liberty Lock.

Empress slips out -> spins -> traps the arm ->RED VELVET GUILLOTINE!

Miss USA fights... claws... fades...

Scott Cooper: She's fading--she's fading--she's out?

DING DING DING!

## Sunday Night SLAM: Episode 2

RING ANNOUNCER

"Here is your winner... and STILL the SWF Women's World Champion... VELVET EMPRESS!"

Crowd boos loudly.

Empress stands tall, cold, emotionless, title raised.

SCOTT "Wait. Something seems way off here. Did Miss USA just take a dive?"

Jimmy V: What do you mean Scott? I didn't see a Finger Poke of Doom. This match wasn't promoted by MVP or Jake Paul or involve Ronda Rousey and Gina Carano.

Valerie Vortex: Woh. Jimmy... put your tin foil hat away!

Scott Cooper: That just didn't seem like the Miss USA we know....

### **8:31 PM - 8:41 PM | Segment 3: The "Actual" Champion's Decree (Non-Match 2)**

Scott Cooper: We are back live on Sunday Night SLAM, and moments ago, Velvet Empress retained the Women's World Championship in a statement victory? I'm still in shock.

Jimmy V "A STATEMENT WRITTEN IN BLOOD AND VELVET, SCOTT."

Valerie Vortex: And the division will feel the effects for weeks.

Scott Cooper: But right now, we shift gears -- because another champion has something to say.

Arena lights dim. A single spotlight hits the stage.

ADAM GLORY (THE SELF-PROCLAIMED "ACTUAL CHAMPION") ENTERS

He walks slowly, confidently, the World Championship slung over his shoulder like a birthright.

Crowd boos loudly.

Jimmy V: OH GREAT, HERE COMES THE MAN WHO BROUGHT HIS OWN HISTORY BOOK.

Valerie Vortex: He's not here to debate. He's here to declare.

Glory enters the ring, raises the mic, and waits for the boos to crest.

## Sunday Night SLAM: Episode 2

ADAM GLORY

"Philadelphia... you're loud. But you're not listening."

Crowd boos louder.

Adam Glory: You can chant for Shawn FX. You can chant for Liger Llama. You can chant for whoever you want... But the truth doesn't care about your volume.

He raises the title.

Adam Glory: This... THIS is the REAL World Championship. Not the one Liger Llama parades around with. Not the one Shawn FX thinks he deserves. This one. The one I earned. The one I never lost."

Crowd erupts in heat.

Scott Cooper: (quietly) He's rewriting the narrative.

Valerie Vortex: He's consolidating power. This is strategic.

Jimmy V: THIS IS A CONSPIRACY UNFOLDING IN REAL TIME.

Adam Glory: Tonight, Shawn FX gets his shot. Not because he earned it. But because I'm generous. I am a FIGHTING champion unlike your DRAMA LLAMA! Where is he anyway? Oh that's right. He's not here. Surprise! Surprise!

He smirks.

Adam Glory: And when he does finally show up I will beat him... When I prove, once again, that I am the rightful, undisputed, UNQUESTIONABLE World Champion... Maybe then you'll finally understand. I am honorable. I am righteous. I am worthy. I AM YOUR REAL SWF WORLD CHAMPION!"

He drops the mic.

Crowd boos relentlessly.

Scott Cooper: Strong words from Adam Glory -- and the controversy only deepens."

Valerie Vortex: He's controlling perception before the match even begins... or so he thinks.

Jimmy V: I NEED A WHITEBOARD AND A LAWYER.

## Sunday Night SLAM: Episode 2

### Carnival Strongman vs Maniac Mechanic

Scott Cooper: We are back on SLAM, and it's time for blue-collar brutality.

Jimmy V: TOOLS, SCOTT. REAL TOOLS. I'M SWEATING.

Valerie Vortex: This will not be pretty.

MANIAC MECHANIC ENTRANCE

Industrial metal hits. Mechanic stomps onto the stage dragging a toolbox behind him.

Crowd pops.

Jimmy V: HE BROUGHT THE WHOLE GARAGE, SCOTT.

Valerie Vortex: "Those tools change the angle and velocity of impact. This is dangerous.

Mechanic slides into the ring, opens the toolbox, and displays a wrench like a trophy.

CARNIVAL STRONGMAN ENTRANCE

Circus-themed rock blasts. Strongman marches out carrying a giant sledgehammer over his shoulder.

Crowd roars.

Scott Cooper: Carnival Strongman -- a walking spectacle of power.

Jimmy V: "A WALKING OSHA VIOLATION."

Strongman slams the hammer onto the stage, sending sparks flying.

MATCH BEGINS

DING DING!

OPENING (0:00-1:30)

Mechanic swings the wrench -- Strongman no-sells it.

Crowd pops.

Jimmy V "HE JUST ATE A WRENCH SHOT LIKE IT WAS BREAKFAST."

## Sunday Night SLAM: Episode 2

Strongman grabs Mechanic by the throat -- tosses him across the ring.

HEAT (1:30-5:00)

Mechanic uses:

Wrench shots

Socket-chain choke

Oil slick on the mat

Strongman slips and crashes into the corner.

Valerie Vortex: That oil changes traction -- it's a clever tactic.

Jimmy V: CLEVER? IT'S A CRIME.

Mechanic hits a running knee with a wrench assist -- near fall.

COMEBACK (5:00-7:00)

Strongman powers up -- roars -- wipes the oil off his boots.

He gorilla-presses Mechanic onto a trash can.

Crowd explodes.

Scott Cooper: Carnival Strongman turning the tide!

HIGH SPOT (7:00-8:00)

Mechanic grabs a power drill. Crowd gasps.

Jimmy V: NO. NO. NO. NO. NO.

Mechanic tries to drill Strongman's boot -- Strongman rips the drill away and snaps it in half.

Crowd erupts.

Valerie Vortex: That's... impressive grip strength.

FINISH (8:00-9:00)

## Sunday Night SLAM: Episode 2

Strongman lifts Mechanic ->TILT-A-WHIRL SLAM onto a pile of tools.

Scott Cooper: That's it! That has to be it!

1-2-3!

DING DING DING!

RING ANNOUNCER

"Here is your winner... CARNIVAL STRONGMAN!"

Strongman roars, pounding his chest.

Mechanic rolls out, clutching his ribs.

POST-MATCH

Jimmy V: I NEED A NAP AND A TETANUS SHOT.

Valerie Vortex: That was decisive. Painful, but decisive. Carnival Strongman is still undefeated in the Superstar Wrestling Federation.

Scott Cooper: Who will stop the Carnival Strongman? We'll be back after this!

### **8:57 PM - 9:00 PM | Segment 5: Backstage Fallout & Lock-Out (Non-Match 3)**

BACKSTAGE -- CAMERA ON A METAL DOOR

The camera rushes into a chaotic scene.

Agents of Order are pounding on a locker room door.

Inside, muffled shouting.

AGENT K "Open the door! This isn't how we do things!"

AGENT I "Protocol demands transparency!"

The door rattles -- someone inside is barricading it.

Suddenly, the door cracks open just enough for a hand to shove a fire extinguisher out into the hallway.

## Sunday Night SLAM: Episode 2

It rolls across the floor.

AGENT K "Oh, that's how we're doing this? Really?"

From inside the room, a voice yells:

ALEJANDRO FUEGO . (O.S.) "¡NO TRESPASSING, NARCOS!"

The door slams shut again.

AGENT I "This is exactly why the tag division is in chaos."

AGENT K "We restore order tonight. In the ring."

They storm off.

Camera pans back to the door.

A sign has been taped to it:

"FUEGO FAMILY MEETING -- NO COPS."

Crowd in the arena politely laughs. Some boo. It's Philly.

## Agents of Order vs Fuego Family

CUT BACK TO RINGSIDE

SCOTT COOPER "Tensions boiling backstage -- and the Agents of Order are not taking that lightly."

JIMMY V "THEY GOT LOCKED OUT BY A FIRE EXTINGUISHER, SCOTT. THAT'S HUMILIATION."

VALERIE VORTEX "It's psychological warfare. The Fuegos thrive on disruption."

SCOTT "And that tag team clash is next."

AGENTS OF ORDER ENTRANCE

Military-style drums hit. Blue spotlights sweep the arena.

Agents of Order march out in perfect sync, saluting the crowd.

## Sunday Night SLAM: Episode 2

SCOTT "The Agents of Order want to restore balance to the tag division."

JIMMY "GOOD LUCK RESTORING ANYTHING IN PHILADELPHIA."

VALERIE "Their strength is structure. Precision. Timing."

They enter the ring with disciplined posture.

FUEGO FAMILY ENTRANCE

Latin trap hits. Orange pyro bursts from the stage.

Alejandro and Domingo dance out, masks glowing, hips moving, full swagger.

Crowd pops huge.

JIMMY "THEY'RE WALKING ARSON, SCOTT."

SCOTT "And remember -- Chi Chi is banned from ringside tonight."

VALERIE "They've never needed 'fair' to win. Only fire."

Fuegos slide into the ring, taunting the Agents.

MATCH BEGINS

DING DING!

Agent K and Domingo start.

Agent K hits a crisp arm drag -> snapmare -> penalty kick.

SCOTT "Textbook precision from the Agents."

VALERIE "Synchronized timing is their greatest asset."

Domingo kips up, slaps Agent K across the face, and dances.

Crowd laughs.

JIMMY "DISRESPECT! I LOVE IT!"

HEAT (2:00-6:00)

## Sunday Night SLAM: Episode 2

Agents isolate Domingowith:

Quick tags

Double shoulder block

Assisted suplex

Near fall.

SCOTT "Order reasserting itself."

VALERIE "They're controlling the center of the ring -- smart strategy."

CHAOS SEQUENCE (8:00-10:00)

All four men in the ring.

Agents hit a double spinebuster -> near fall.

Fuegos hit stereo dives to the outside.

Crowd chanting: "FUEGO! FUEGO! FUEGO!"

VALERIE "Improvisation is a weapon -- and the Fuegos wield it well."

FINISH (10:00-11:00)

Agents go for their finisher -- Order Restored.

Alejandro slips out -> grabs Agent K's tights -> rolls him up -> Feet on the ropes.

1-2-3!

DING DING DING!

RING ANNOUNCER

"Here are your winners... THE FUEGO FAMILY!"

Crowd cheers wildly.

Agents of Order argue with the referee.

## Sunday Night SLAM: Episode 2

Fuegos dance up the ramp, pointing at the Agents and laughing.

POST-MATCH

SCOTT "A huge win for the Fuego Family -- and the tag division continues to evolve."

JIMMY "THEY BURNED DOWN THE BLUEPRINT AND SALTED THE EARTH."

VALERIE "Let's check the rankings."

### 9:21 PM - 9:27 PM | Segment 7: The Top 5 Snapshot (Non-Match 4)

SCOTT COOPER "A huge win for the Fuego Family -- and the tag division continues to evolve."

JIMMY V "THEY BURNED DOWN THE BLUEPRINT AND DANCED ON THE ASHES."

VALERIE VORTEX "And speaking of evolving divisions... let's take a look at the Power Rankings."

Arena lights dim slightly. SLAMtron displays the updated rankings.

Crowd reacts with a mix of cheers and murmurs.

SCOTT

"Miss USA remains in the number three spot despite her loss tonight -- a testament to her momentum coming in."

VALERIE "Rankings aren't just about wins and losses. They're about performance, trajectory, and division impact."

## Sunday Night SLAM: Episode 2

JIMMY "AND POLITICS. DON'T FORGET POLITICS."

VALERIE "No, Jimmy. That's just you."

SCOTT

"And now we shift to a match that will directly affect another division -- the Internet Championship picture."

JIMMY "CYBORG VS LION, SCOTT. I'M READY."

VALERIE "Precision versus power. A classic tempo conflict."

### Victor Steele vs Leo Maximus

VICTOR STEELE ENTRANCE

Cold, mechanical synth hits. Blue strobe lights pulse in perfect rhythm.

Victor Steele walks out with robotic precision -- no wasted motion.

Scott Cooper: Victor Steele -- a machine of efficiency.

Valerie Vortex: Watch his footwork. Every step is calculated.

Jimmy V: I'M PRETTY SURE HE HAS A SERIAL NUMBER. Mine is....

Steele enters the ring, stretching his neck with mechanical stiffness.

LEO MAXIMUS ENTRANCE

Heavy rock hits. Golden spotlights sweep the arena.

Leo Maximus bursts onto the stage, roaring, pounding his chest.

Crowd pops huge.

Scott Cooper: Leo Maximus -- a lion-hearted powerhouse with something to prove.

Jimmy V: HE BENCH-PRESSED A BUICK THIS MORNING. I SAW IT. I bought it!

Valerie Vortex: His power is undeniable -- but Steele will try to dismantle him piece by piece."

## Sunday Night SLAM: Episode 2

Maximus slides into the ring, staring down Steele.

MATCH BEGINS

DING DING!

OPENING (0:00-2:00)

Chain wrestling. Steele transitions from wristlock -> hammerlock -> takedown.

Valerie Steele: Steele's mechanics are flawless. So tough.

Maximus powers out, shoves Steele across the ring.

Crowd cheers.

Jimmy V: THE LION JUST YEETED THE CYBORG. When is the last time you saw Brooklyn's finest tossed like that?

SHINE (2:00-4:00)

Maximus hits:

Shoulder block

Running powerslam

Delayed vertical suplex

Near fall.

Scott Cooper: Maximus using raw strength to take early control.

HEAT (4:00-8:00)

Steele chop-blocks the knee. Targets the leg with:

Grounded kicks

Kneebar variations

Dragon screw

## Sunday Night SLAM: Episode 2

Valerie Vortex: He's isolating the knee to limit Maximus' base -- smart strategy.

Jimmy V: HE'S TRYING TO TURN THE LION INTO A HOUSECAT. Meow!

COMEBACK (8:00-10:00)

Maximus powers out of a kneebar ->Hits a spinebuster that shakes the ring.

Crowd erupts.

Scott Cooper: Leo Maximus digging deep!

Jimmy V: THE LION IS ROARING!

FINISH (10:00-12:00)

Maximus goes for Lion's Roar (running knee) --His knee buckles.

Steele grabs him instantly ->PRECISION DRIVER (snap brainbuster).

Scott Cooper: Precision Driver! That's it!

1-2-3!

Jimmy V: Wait. No? His foot was on the ropes!

Scott Cooper: Victor is arguing with the referee?

Valerie Vortex: Oh! Leo Maximus with a dastardly low blow from behind in desperation!

Jimmy V: Leo has Victor rolled up and he has the tights! HA!

Scott Cooper: 1... 2... and 3??? Not like this!

DING DING DING!

RING ANNOUNCER

"Here is your winner... and the NEW number one contender to the Internet Championship... LEOOOOOOOO MAXIMUS!"

Maximus stands over Steele, cold, emotionless.

## Sunday Night SLAM: Episode 2

He points to the camera.

Leo Maximus: "Muchacho... recalibrate."

Crowd reacts loudly.

### POST-MATCH

Scott Cooper: A massive win for The Paragon of Perfection I've been instructed from the booth to call Mr. Leo Maximus -- and he now moves on to challenge Masked Muchacho.

Jimmy V: Leo! Leo! LEO! LEO!

Valerie Vortex: He earned that? Clean execution? That was perfection? Hardly!

### 9:42 PM - 9:46 PM | Segment 9: Scouting the Trend (Non-Match 5)

Scott Cooper: A massive win for Leo Maximus nonetheless -- and he now becomes the number one contender to the Internet Championship.

Jimmy V: HE'S TRENDING, SCOTT. I CAN FEEL IT IN MY BONES.

Valerie Vortex: Let's take a closer look at the Internet division.

Lights dim.SLAMtron displays a stylized data-driven package.

SLAMTRON PACKAGE -- "SCOUTING THE TREND"

Graphics show:

Masked Muchacho (champion)

Leo Maximus (new #1 contender)

Victor Steele (falling one spot)

Thaddeus B Deveraux (rising)

Carnival Strongman (steady)

Each profile flashes with stats, highlights, and social metrics.

Valerie Vortex (V.O.)

"Masked Muchacho remains the most unpredictable champion in the SWF. His agility and improvisation make him difficult to prepare for."

Scott Cooper (V.O.) "Leo Maximus, on the other hand, is pure precision. No wasted motion. No wasted energy."

Jimmy V (V.O.) "AND NO EMOTIONS. HE'S LIKE A TOASTER WITH ABS."

BACK TO RINGSIDE

Valerie Vortex: Are you guys seriously reading what they're writing for you with a straight face? What a disgrace! Did I step into an episode of the Twilight Zone? Meanwhile... This next matchup is a clash of styles -- chaos versus calculation.

Scott Cooper: And it's coming sooner than later.

Jimmy V: I'M BUYING STOCK IN MUCHACHO MASKS.

Valerie Vortex: That's not how stocks work.

Jimmy V: "IT IS IN MY HEART."

Valerie Vortex: You literally just read what someone wrote for you to say out loud.

## Sunday Night SLAM: Episode 2

The cold stare

The whisper to Miss USA

Overlay text: "THE EMPRESS DECIDES WHO ASCENDS."

Cut to Empress seated on a throne-like chair backstage, title across her lap.

She speaks softly, but every word cuts.

VELVET EMPRESS

"Tonight... the division was reminded."

She runs her fingers across the championship plate.

EMPRESS "Reminded that elegance is earned. Reminded that excellence is demanded. Reminded... that I am inevitable."

She looks directly into the camera.

EMPRESS "Miss USA fought bravely. But bravery is not enough. Not against royalty."

She stands, lifting the title.

EMPRESS "And to every woman in this division... Prepare yourselves."

She tilts her head, smiling faintly.

EMPRESS "CONVERGENCE approaches. And I will decide who is worthy."

The screen floods with crimson.

.... "Ahem"

Velvet Empress: Miss.... USA... What are YOU doing back here?

"Miss USA" removes her mask.

Jinx Jester: SURPRISE! I ALMOST HAD YOU TONIGHT!

Velvet Empress: What? You? HOW?

The Velvet Empress is attacked by Jinx Jester & The Trickster Sister

BACK TO RINGSIDE

Scott Cooper: Someone get back there! I'm no fan of the Velvet Empress but this is escalating quickly!

Jimmy V: THE AGENTS OF CHAOS ARE SENDING A MESSAGE IN ALL CAPS AND BLOOD RED!

Valerie Vortex: Velvet Empress didn't actually wrestle Miss USA? She fought Jinx Jester wearing Miss USA's original mask?

Scott Cooper: I knew something was off! And now this calculated and premeditated beatdown as security has intervened... AND the MAIN EVENT is just moments away....

Jimmy V: Velvet's bleeding! Somebody help!

### 9:50 PM - 9:53 PM | Segment 11: Final Walk to the Ring (Non-Match 7)

BACKSTAGE -- SHAWN FX

Camera opens on Shawn FX pacing in the hallway, bouncing on his toes, headphones around his neck, energy radiating off him.

A backstage interviewer approaches.

Tess Toretz: Shawn, tonight you face Adam Glory for the World Championship. Your thoughts before heading out?

FX pulls off his headphones, eyes blazing.

SHAWN FX My thoughts? Simple. Adam Glory says he's the 'actual' champion. He says he never lost. He says he's inevitable.

He steps closer to the camera.

FX: But tonight... I show him what's real.

Crowd in the arena pops.

FX: I'm not here to debate history. I'm here to make it.

He slaps his chest twice, nods, and storms toward gorilla.

## Sunday Night SLAM: Episode 2

CUT TO -- ADAM GLORY

Glory stands in front of a mirror, adjusting the World Championship on his shoulder.

He smirks at his reflection.

GLORY "Tonight... I correct the record."

He turns to the camera.

GLORY "FX is talented. But he's emotional. Predictable. Breakable."

He taps the title plate.

GLORY "And I? I am undeniable."

He walks toward gorilla with cold confidence.

BACK TO RINGSIDE

Scott Cooper: The main event is moments away -- and both men are entering with something to prove.

Jimmy V: I CAN'T FEEL MY FACE, SCOTT. We need an update on the Velvet Empress!

Valerie Vortex: This will be a test of emotional discipline. That's what they wrote for me to say about the Main Event tonight. Wow. Compelling writing production truck. Thanks.

## Adam Glory vs Shawn FX

SHAWN FX ENTRANCE

Everything Zen by Bush hits. The Philly crowd loves it and are on their feet singing along. Blue and neon strobes explode across the stage.

FX bursts out, sprinting to the edge of the ramp, hyping the crowd.

Crowd erupts.

Scott Cooper: Shawn FX -- the human highlight reel, the spark plug, the man who thrives under pressure. Ok, I'm with you Val. This stuff they're writing for us to say about Shawn FX had to be written by AI. Thankfully we're live. Shawn FX is the UNDISPUTED ONE! Better?

## Sunday Night SLAM: Episode 2

Jimmy V: HE'S A FIREWORK WITH LEGS. (Singing) BABY YOU'RE A FIIIIIRE WORK! COME ON LET YOUR COOOOLORS BURST!

FX slides into the ring, bouncing, ready to explode.

Valerie Vortex: Jimmy! Throw that script away and help us call the match and stop singing! PLEASE!

ADAM GLORY ENTRANCE

Lights drop. A single golden spotlight hits the stage.

Orchestral rock swells.

Adam Glory steps out slowly, the World Championship raised high.

Crowd boos loudly.

Scott Cooper: Adam Glory -- the self-proclaimed rightful, undisputed World Champion.

Jimmy V: HE BROUGHT HIS OWN HISTORY BOOK AND IT'S WRONG OR MAYBE IT'S RIGHT? WHO REALLY KNOWS?

Valerie Vortex: He's controlling tempo before the bell even rings. Yep, a corporate line I was paid to say. I said it. Now what?

Glory enters the ring, staring down FX with icy disdain.

MATCH BEGINS

DING DING!

OPENING (0:00-3:00)

Slow, tense circling.

FX tries to speed up -- Glory grabs a wrist, slows him down.

Scott Cooper: Glory imposing his pace early.

Valerie Vortex: Glory wants to frustrate FX. Emotional fighters make mistakes. Yeah, that's definitely AI that wrote this script for us tonight.

Meanwhile the Philadelphia fans are chanting GLORYHOLE audibly at Adam Glory.

## Sunday Night SLAM: Episode 2

FX breaks free -> hits a quick dropkick -> crowd pops.

Jimmy V: "THE SPARK PLUG IS IGNITING!"

Valerie: "If you say "Spark Plug" again tonight... just ONE MORE TIME I swear!"

The GLORYHOLE chants get louder.

FX SHINE (3:00-6:00)

FX hits:

Springboard dropkick

Running knee

Suicide dive to the outside

Crowd surges.

Scott Cooper: Shawn FX is rolling!

Jimmy V: "I'M SWEATING THROUGH MY SUIT IN BUCKETS!"

Valerie Vortex: Take your jacket off! See how dumb they make you sound, Jimmy? I told you to throw that script away!

GLORY (HOLE) HEAT (6:00-12:00)

FX goes for a springboard -- Glory catches him mid-air ->Backbreaker.

Glory slows the match to a crawl:

Rib work

Grounded holds

Knee strikes to the midsection

Valerie Vortex: Ahem - He's targeting the ribs to limit FX's aerial offense.

Jimmy V: HE'S TRYING TO TURN FX INTO A FLOOR MODEL.

Valerie Vortex rolls her eyes.

FX COMEBACK (12:00-15:00)

FX counters a suplex ->Tornado DDT!

Crowd explodes.

FX hits:

Superkick

Running knee

Standing moonsault

Near fall.

Scott Cooper: FX is one move away!

Jimmy V: PHILLY IS FOAMING AT THE MOUTH!

HIGH DRAMA (15:00-17:00)

FX goes for his finisher -- Flashpoint.

Valerie Vortex: Flashpoint and not Special FX? That's bold.

Glory shoves the referee into the ropes ->FX slips -> crashes.

Ref bump.

Crowd boos.

Scott Cooper: Oh come on!

Valerie Vortex: That was intentional. He created chaos.

FX recovers -> hits Flashpoint anyway!

Covers -- but no ref.

Crowd counts to ten.

## Sunday Night SLAM: Episode 2

FINISH (17:00-18:00)

Second referee slides in.

FX lifts Glory --Glory low-blows him behind the ref's back.

Crowd erupts in fury.

Jimmy V: ILLEGAL! ILLEGAL! ILLEGAL! I LOVE IT!

Glory hits Glory Bomb.

Scott Copper: Wait. This referee running in is.... BEN HALL?

1-2... 3!????!

DING DING DING!

Scott Cooper: That has to be the fastest count I've ever seen. What the heck is going on?

RING ANNOUNCER

"Here is your winner... ADAM GLORY!"

The hot Philadelphia crowd boos relentlessly.

Glory grabs the title, clutching it like a crown.

POST-MATCH -- THE MOUNTAIN WATCHES

Lights shift.

Camera cuts to the rafters.

A single spotlight reveals:

What the heck? That's.... BIG BUSINESS!

He stares down at Glory.

Crowd explodes.

Scott Cooper: Big Business is watching -- and the controversy only deepens!

Jimmy V: PHILLY IS ABOUT TO RIOT AND I'M INTO IT!

Valerie Vortex: This insanity is far from over. Shawn FX just suffered what seems to be a PHILADELPHIA SCREWJOB at the hands of BIG BUSINESS and... whoever that referee is?"

SCOTT (SIGN-OFF)

"For everyone here at the Superstar Wrestling Federation...This has been Sunday Night SLAM. Goodnight from Philadelphia."

Jimmy V: Ben Hall just flipped off Shawn FX outside the ring and laughed. We can't go off the air now! No, please not yet!

Shawn FX just dove to the floor on top of a pile of security to try to get to referee Ben Hall! Ben is still taunting him! Are we still on the air????

Jimmy V: BEN HALL WITH A CHEAPSHOT! SHAWN FX JUST GOT ROCKED! I LOVE IT!

The locker room empties out.
