May 24, 2026 | Prudential Center - Newark, New Jersey

Big Mama Johnson vs Diamond Dana Cortez

Live from the Prudential Center -- Newark, NJ

Attendance: 14,822 screaming fans who definitely did not read the waiver about "possible emotional damage."

? Opening Segment

The camera swoops across the roaring Newark crowd as pyro detonates like someone gave a toddler a box of fireworks and zero supervision. Signs fill the arena:

- "LLAMA NATION = SALVATION"
- "CASSIUS CROWN IS MY DAD (HE DOESN'T KNOW)"
- "BIG MAMA ATE MY CAR"
- "DANA CORTEZ INVENTED WRESTLING"

At the desk, Roxy Reed, Hector Rodriguez, and Tess Taylor stand ready.

Roxy Reed: "Welcome to Sunday Night SLAM, where the matches are hot, the rivalries are hotter, and the insurance premiums are astronomical."

Hector Rodriguez: "Tonight we find out if Cassius Crown can finally take the throne from Liger Llama, if Safari Jackson can get revenge on G Money, and if GNOME! survives being used as a projectile."

Tess Taylor: "But first--two of the most dangerous women in the SWF collide. Big Mama Johnson. Diamond Dana Cortez. Someone's leaving with momentum. Someone's leaving with a limp."

Cut to a split-screen:

Big Mama Johnson pacing like a tank with legs.

Diamond Dana Cortez stretching with laser-focused precision.

Roxy Reed: "Let's not waste another second. It's time to fight."

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Ring Announcer:

"Introducing first... from Detroit, Michigan... weighing in at 'none of your damn business'... the Queen of Clobberin'... BIG! MAMA! JOHNSON!"

Big Mama stomps down the ramp, shoulders rolling, jaw clenched, radiating "I will suplex your soul" energy. The crowd pops huge.

Ring Announcer:

"And her opponent... from San Diego, California... the technical tactician... the Diamond Standard... DIAMOND! DANA! CORTEZ!"

Dana emerges calm, composed, and razor-sharp. She points to Big Mama like she's already dissecting her.

THE MATCH

Opening Exchange

The bell rings.

Big Mama charges like a freight train. Dana sidesteps, snatches a waistlock, and tries to drag the bigger woman down. Big Mama just stands there--unmoved--then hip-checks Dana across the ring like she's swatting a fly.

Hector Rodriguez: "Dana Cortez just discovered gravity has favorites."

Dana rolls through, pops up, and fires off three stiff calf kicks. Big Mama eats them, snarls, and swings a lariat that would decapitate a lesser mortal. Dana ducks, rebounds, and hits a running dropkick to the knee, finally staggering the giant.

Middle Sequence

Dana goes full technician:

- Dragon screw
- Basement dropkick
- Kneebar attempt

Big Mama roars, deadlifts Dana out of the kneebar, and slams her down with a one-armed powerbomb that shakes the ring.

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Tess Taylor: "That wasn't a counter. That was a public service announcement."

Big Mama drags Dana up, hits a Belly-to-Belly Throw, then a corner avalanche that folds Dana like a lawn chair.

Momentum Shift

Big Mama goes for the Mama Splash--

Dana rolls out.

Big Mama crashes hard.

Dana immediately pounces with:

- Shining Wizard
- Snap DDT
- Diamond Lock (Crossface variation)

Big Mama claws toward the ropes, refusing to tap. She powers up, lifting Dana ON HER BACK while still in the hold, and drops backward to break it.

Final Minute

Both women stagger up.

Dana hits a spinning backfist.

Big Mama answers with a headbutt that echoes through Newark.

Dana collapses.

Big Mama hauls her up...

MAMA BOMB (Sit-out Powerbomb)

Cover.

1... 2... 3.

WINNER: BIG MAMA JOHNSON

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Big Mama stands tall, breathing heavy, pointing at the camera.

Big Mama Johnson:

"Velvet Empress... I'm comin' for you next."

Dana sits up, frustrated but nodding--she knows she pushed Big Mama to the limit.

Roxy Reed: "If this is how we're starting SLAM tonight, the rest of the card might actually kill someone."

Chaos Engine vs Realm Wardens

? OPENING CALL

SCOTT COOPER:

"Alright folks, after an absolutely wild start to Sunday Night SLAM, we finally settle into tag team action. Chaos Engine -- Jack and Jake Jester -- taking on the Realm Wardens, Sentinel and Vanguard."

JIMMY V:

"And look at the Jesters, Scott! They're grinning like they just watched the world's greatest bar fight. This is their comfort zone!"

VALERIE VORTEX:

"The Wardens, by contrast, are composed and focused. They're here to wrestle, not revel in disorder."

? LOCKUP -- SENTINEL vs. JACK JESTER

The bell rings.

Jack Jester circles Sentinel, clowning, dancing, trying to throw him off.

Sentinel doesn't bite.

They lock up -- Sentinel immediately powers Jack back into the corner.

SCOTT:

"Sentinel showing that raw strength early."

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JIMMY V:

"Jack's smiling! Why is he smiling?!"

Jack slips under Sentinel's arm, pops behind him, and delivers a quick waistlock takedown.

Sentinel rolls through, pops up, and shoulder blocks Jack flat.

VALERIE:

"Classic mismatch of styles. Jack relies on misdirection; Sentinel relies on fundamentals."

? TAG TO VANGUARD -- DOUBLE TEAM CONTROL

Sentinel tags in Vanguard.

They hit a clean double hip toss, followed by a double elbow drop.

Willy D slides in for the count -- a normal one this time.

ONE!

TWO!

Kickout.

SCOTT:

"Good teamwork from the Wardens. They're keeping Jack isolated."

JIMMY V:

"Willy D counted at a normal speed! Mark your calendars!"

? CHAOS ENGINE FIRES BACK

Jack crawls between Vanguard's legs, pops up behind him, and slaps the back of his head.

Vanguard turns -- annoyed.

Jack tags Jake.

Jake springboards in with a flying crossbody, hooks the leg--

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ONE!

TWO!

Kickout.

Jake stays on him with rapid-fire forearms, then a running knee lift.

VALERIE:

"Chaos Engine excels when they can speed the match up. They're forcing Vanguard to react instead of dictate."

? MID-MATCH MOMENTUM SHIFT

Jake goes for a running bulldog --

Vanguard blocks it, lifts him, and drives him into the Wardens' corner.

Tag to Sentinel.

Sentinel unloads with measured, heavy strikes -- body shot, body shot, uppercut.

Jake stumbles.

Sentinel hits a sidewalk slam.

ONE!

TWO!

Jack breaks it up.

SCOTT:

"Jack saves the match for his team!"

JIMMY V:

"And Willy D is yelling at him like he's got any control over this!"

? HOT TAG SEQUENCE

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Sentinel goes for a back suplex --

Jake flips out, lands on his feet, dives--

TAG TO JACK!

Jack storms in with:

- Running forearm
- Spinning elbow
- Dropkick to Sentinel
- Dropkick to Vanguard on the apron

The crowd pops.

Jack hits a running neckbreaker on Sentinel.

ONE!

TWO!

Sentinel powers out.

VALERIE:

"Jack's offense is unpredictable, but Sentinel's durability is the equalizer."

? CHAOS ENGINE DOUBLE TEAM

Jake returns.

They hit their signature:

"Engine Block" -- a wheelbarrow into a codebreaker.

Sentinel drops hard.

Jake covers--

ONE!

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TWO!

Vanguard dives in to break it!

? WARDENS TAKE BACK CONTROL

Vanguard tosses Jake out.

Sentinel catches Jack with a big boot.

Tag.

The Wardens hit a clean, crisp double spinebuster.

ONE!

TWO!

THR-- JACK KICKS OUT!

SCOTT:

"Jack Jester showing incredible resilience!"

JIMMY V:

"He's too stubborn to stay down!"

? CLOSING STRETCH -- REALM WARDENS TAKE OVER

Jack Jester is the legal man, staggering after the double spinebuster.

Sentinel pulls him up, tags Vanguard, and the Wardens shift into clinical, methodical tag wrestling.

SCOTT COOPER:

"The Wardens are tightening the screws now. This is where they excel -- control, pressure, precision."

JIMMY V:

"Jack looks like he's trying to remember what planet he's on!"

VALERIE VORTEX:

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"Sentinel and Vanguard are isolating him perfectly. This is textbook tag strategy."

? WARDENS' FINAL SEQUENCE

Vanguard whips Jack into the ropes --

Sentinel steps in and cuts him in half with a huge shoulder block.

Jake tries to rush in --

Sentinel meets him with a big boot, sending him rolling out of the ring.

Willy D tries to restore order, but the Wardens are already setting up the finish.

SCOTT:

"They've got Jack right where they want him!"

? THE FINISH -- "THE VERDICT"

Sentinel hoists Jack up in a fireman's carry.

Vanguard hits the ropes, rebounds, and delivers a running lariat as Sentinel drops Jack forward.

Jack hits the mat HARD.

Vanguard covers.

Willy D slides in:

ONE!

TWO!

THREE!

The bell rings.

? POST-MATCH CALL

SCOTT COOPER:

"A clean, definitive victory for the Realm Wardens! No shortcuts, no chaos -- just disciplined tag team

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wrestling."

JIMMY V:

"And the Chaos Engine is rolling out of the ring like they just got hit by a truck made of discipline!"

VALERIE VORTEX:

"The Wardens needed this win. It reestablishes them as a serious force in the division."

? WINNERS: THE REALM WARDENS

Sentinel and Vanguard stand tall, composed, raising their fists in unison.

Chaos Engine regroup at ringside, laughing through the pain -- because of course they do.

Willy D looks relieved to still be alive.

Safari Jackson vs G Money

? REPLAY PACKAGE -- "LAST TIME ON SUNDAY NIGHT SLAM..."

The screen flickers to the signature SLAM replay filter -- black-and-gold with the deep bass stinger.

SCOTT COOPER (V.O.):

"Let's take you back to the very first episode of Sunday Night SLAM..."

We see the footage:

- Safari Jackson hitting the Safari Splash on Cassius Crown.
- The crowd on their feet.
- Safari hooking the leg.
- The referee sliding into position.

ONE!

TWO!--

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Suddenly:

G MONEY yanks Safari out of the ring by the ankle.

JIMMY V (V.O.):

"This moment right here changed the entire trajectory of the SWF World Championship picture!"

G Money throws Safari into the steel steps.

Cassius Crown, dazed but opportunistic, watches from inside the ring.

Safari tries to crawl back in --

G Money grabs him again, slams him into the barricade.

Cassius hits the Prime Time Elbow.

Covers.

ONE!

TWO!

THREE!

Cassius Crown becomes the No. 1 Contender.

Safari Jackson is left staring daggers at G Money.

? BACK TO LIVE -- COMMENTARY TABLE

SCOTT COOPER:

"And that brings us to tonight. The fallout from that moment has been simmering for weeks, and it all comes to a head right now."

VALERIE VORTEX:

"Safari Jackson had the match won. He had the opportunity of a lifetime in his hands. G Money took that from him."

JIMMY V:

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"And now Safari wants payback, Scott. He wants revenge. He wants justice. He wants ALL of it!"

? MAIN EVENT REMINDER -- HUGE STAKES TONIGHT

The graphic appears:

MAIN EVENT

CASSIUS CROWN vs. LIGER LLAMA

NO. 1 CONTENDER vs. SWF WORLD CHAMPION

TONIGHT

SCOTT:

"And remember -- Cassius Crown challenges Liger Llama for the SWF World Championship later tonight."

VALERIE:

"But first, the man he stole the contendership from wants to settle the score."

? CASSIUS CROWN BANNED FROM RINGSIDE

A red "BANNED FROM RINGSIDE" stamp slams onto the screen.

SCOTT:

"And per the General Manager's ruling -- Cassius Crown is banned from ringside for the next match."

JIMMY V:

"If he shows up, he forfeits his title shot! That's the biggest punishment you can hand a man like Cassius!"

VALERIE:

"Which means Safari Jackson and G Money will settle this one-on-one. No interference. No excuses."

? UP NEXT -- SAFARI JACKSON vs. G MONEY

The camera cuts to the entranceway as the crowd rises.

SCOTT:

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"It's time. Safari Jackson. G Money. The grudge match weeks in the making."

JIMMY V:

"Safari's coming in with a score to settle and a point to prove!"

VALERIE:

"And G Money? He's coming in with a target on his back."

? COMMENTARY SETS THE STAGE

SCOTT COOPER:

"Ladies and gentlemen, this one has been brewing since the very first episode of Sunday Night SLAM. Safari Jackson had the No. 1 Contendership in his hands... until G Money ripped it away."

JIMMY V:

"And Safari has been waiting WEEKS to get his hands on him!"

VALERIE VORTEX:

"And with Cassius Crown banned from ringside, this is as fair as it gets."

? THE BELL RINGS

Safari storms out of his corner -- G Money meets him center ring --

they start throwing hands IMMEDIATELY.

No collar-and-elbow.

No feeling-out.

Just fists.

SCOTT:

"Safari isn't here to wrestle -- he's here to fight!"

JIMMY V:

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"G Money's swinging right back! This is a street fight in a wrestling ring!"

? SAFARI TAKES EARLY CONTROL

Safari backs G Money into the corner with rapid-fire punches.

Willy D tries to separate them -- Safari shoves past him and hits a running clothesline.

G Money staggers out -- Safari hits a snap powerslam.

ONE!

TWO!

Kickout.

VALERIE:

"Safari's aggression is high, but he's staying within the rules. That's discipline under pressure."

? G MONEY FIRES BACK

Safari goes for a suplex --

G Money blocks it, drives a knee into the ribs, and hits a sharp European uppercut.

Safari stumbles --

G Money hits a running STO, planting him hard.

ONE!

TWO!

Safari kicks out.

SCOTT:

"G Money showing he's not just a talker -- he's got real power."

JIMMY V:

"And he's got something to prove after weeks of being called a coward!"

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? MID-MATCH MOMENTUM SHIFT

G Money whips Safari into the ropes --

Safari ducks a clothesline --

Safari rebounds with a flying shoulder tackle.

Safari hits the ropes again --

BIG leaping leg drop.

He covers:

ONE!

TWO!

G Money kicks out.

Safari pulls him up --

G Money rakes the eyes behind Willy D's back.

VALERIE:

"Classic shortcut. G Money knows he needs to slow Safari down."

? G MONEY'S HEAT SEGMENT

G Money hits:

- A DDT

- A running knee to the jaw

- A lariat that flips Safari inside-out

He covers:

ONE!

TWO!

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Safari kicks out again.

SCOTT:

"Safari Jackson refuses to stay down!"

JIMMY V:

"He's got that jungle-born stubbornness!"

? SAFARI'S COMEBACK

G Money goes for a second lariat --

Safari ducks --

Safari hits a spinebuster that shakes the ring.

Crowd pops.

Safari kips up.

Safari hits:

- Running forearm

- Running forearm

- Jumping clothesline

G Money is rocked.

Safari signals for the Safari Splash.

SCOTT:

"He's calling for it!"

? G MONEY COUNTERS

Safari climbs the ropes --

G Money rolls out of the way.

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Safari hops down --

G Money charges --

Safari catches him with a Samoan drop.

Safari covers--

ONE!

TWO!

THR-- NO! G Money kicks out!

VALERIE:

"Safari is inches away from victory."

? FINISH SEQUENCE -- CLEAN, DECISIVE

Safari pulls G Money up --

G Money shoves him into the ropes --

Safari rebounds --

G Money swings wildly --

Safari ducks --

Safari hits the Safari Slam (spinning side slam).

The crowd erupts.

Safari climbs the ropes.

SCOTT:

"He's going for it again!"

Safari leaps--

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SAFARI SPLASH!

He hooks the leg.

ONE!

TWO!

THREE!

The bell rings.

? WINNER: SAFARI JACKSON

Safari rolls to his knees, pounding his chest, roaring in triumph.

G Money rolls out of the ring, clutching his ribs, furious and humiliated.

SCOTT:

"Safari Jackson gets his revenge!"

JIMMY V:

"And G Money has NO excuses tonight!"

VALERIE:

"Safari needed this win. And now he can finally move forward."

Small Business & Micro-Manager vs GNOME! & Cyclone the Angry Dwarf

? BACKSTAGE: SMALL BUSINESS & MICRO-MANAGER MELTDOWN

The camera cuts to the hallway outside Gorilla.

Small Business is pacing like a man who just got hit with an unexpected audit.

Micro-Manager is waving his clipboard like a weapon, barking orders at a man twice his size.

MICRO-MANAGER:

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"NO, NO, NO -- YOU DON'T JUST WALK OUT THERE! YOU STRATEGIZE! YOU EXECUTE! YOU FOLLOW THE PLAN!"

SMALL BUSINESS:

"What plan?! You rewrote it three times since lunch!"

Micro-Manager jabs the clipboard into his chest.

MICRO-MANAGER:

"BECAUSE YOU KEEP MESSING IT UP!"

Small Business growls, fists clenching.

SMALL BUSINESS:

"I'm about to mess you up if you don't stop yelling at me."

Micro-Manager freezes.

Looks up.

Realizes he's yelling at a man built like a forklift.

He clears his throat.

MICRO-MANAGER:

"Professionally speaking... noted."

? REPLAY -- EPISODE 1: THE MINI DIVISION ALLIANCE

The screen cuts to a replay from the first episode of Sunday Night SLAM.

SCOTT COOPER (V.O.):

"Let's not forget how this rivalry began..."

We see:

- Cyclone the Angry Dwarf being double-teamed by Small Business & Micro-Manager.

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- GNOME! popping out from under the ring apron like a gremlin with a grudge.
- The crowd exploding as GNOME! bites Small Business's arm.
- Cyclone hitting a running headbutt that sends Micro-Manager tumbling like a bowling pin.
- The two Minis standing tall together for the first time.

JIMMY V (V.O.):

"That was the night the Mini Division changed forever! Cyclone and GNOME! -- sworn enemies -- teaming up to fight off corporate oppression!"

VALERIE VORTEX (V.O.):

"And tonight, they're forced to coexist again... but this time, Cyclone is the Mini World Champion."

? BACK TO LIVE -- COMMENTARY

SCOTT COOPER:

"Cyclone the Angry Dwarf and GNOME! may not like each other, but they've proven they can unite when the situation demands it."

JIMMY V:

"And nothing unites people faster than a common enemy -- especially when that enemy is Small Business and his walking clipboard!"

VALERIE VORTEX:

"Small Business & Micro-Manager are dysfunctional, but dangerous. Cyclone and GNOME! are chaotic, but effective. This match is unpredictable."

? UP NEXT: MINI WORLD CHAMPION CYCLONE & GNOME! vs. SMALL BUSINESS & MICRO-MANAGER

The graphic flashes across the screen.

SCOTT:

"Tag team action in the Mini Division -- and it's coming up next!"

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?? ENTRANCE: CYCLONE THE ANGRY DWARF (Mini World Champion)

The lights shift to a sharp storm-blue.

A rumble of thunder hits the speakers -- not supernatural, just production design.

The crowd pops BIG.

SCOTT COOPER:

"Here comes the Mini World Champion -- Cyclone the Angry Dwarf!"

Cyclone bursts through the curtain like he was fired out of a cannon.

Mini World Title strapped around his waist, beard bristling, eyes wide with fury.

He stomps down the ramp with purpose, yelling at fans, yelling at the camera, yelling at the air.

JIMMY V:

"He's angry at EVERYTHING, Scott! The fans! The lights! The floor! The concept of gravity!"

Cyclone hops onto the apron, slaps the turnbuckle, and climbs the second rope, raising the Mini World Title high.

The crowd roars.

VALERIE VORTEX:

"Cyclone may be volatile, but he's the champion for a reason. He's explosive, unpredictable, and relentless."

Cyclone drops down and paces like a caged animal, waiting for his... partner.

?? ENTRANCE: GNOME!

The lights dim slightly.

A single spotlight hits the stage.

Silence.

Then a tiny rustling sound.

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The crowd starts laughing -- they know what's coming.

GNOME! pops out from behind the curtain like he wasn't sure he wanted to be here but decided chaos was worth it.

He adjusts his crooked red hat.

He scratches his beard.

He looks left.

He looks right.

He grins.

SCOTT:

"And here comes GNOME! The most unpredictable Mini in the SWF!"

GNOME! scurries down the ramp, stopping every few feet to glare at fans, point at Cyclone, or pick up imaginary objects from the floor.

Cyclone watches him with pure suspicion.

JIMMY V:

"Look at Cyclone! He doesn't trust GNOME! as far as he can throw him -- and he can't throw him very far!"

GNOME! slides into the ring, circles Cyclone, then pats the Mini World Title like it's a pet.

Cyclone swats his hand away.

GNOME! giggles.

VALERIE:

"They don't like each other. They don't trust each other. But when they're forced to work together? They're dangerous."

Cyclone and GNOME! stand side-by-side -- not by choice, but by circumstance -- as the crowd buzzes for the Mini Division showcase.

?? ENTRANCE: SMALL BUSINESS & MICRO-MANAGER

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The lights shift to a smug corporate gold, with a faint "ding" sound like an elevator arriving.

The crowd immediately boos -- they know EXACTLY who's coming.

SCOTT COOPER:

"Here come Small Business and Micro-Manager -- and they do NOT look like they're on the same page tonight."

JIMMY V:

"They're never on the same page! They're not even in the same book! One's a walking tax audit and the other's a sentient clipboard!"

? SMALL BUSINESS -- The Mini Enforcer of Capitalism

Small Business steps through the curtain first, chest puffed out, suit vest stretched to its absolute limit.

He adjusts his tie, points to the crowd, and mouths:

"You people couldn't afford me!"

The boos get louder.

He smirks.

He LOVES it.

He marches down the ramp with the swagger of a man who thinks he owns the building -- even though he's three feet tall and furious about it.

? MICRO-MANAGER -- The Bureaucratic Menace

Micro-Manager bursts out behind him, already yelling.

Clipboard raised.

Pen clicking like a machine gun.

Tie crooked from stress.

MICRO-MANAGER:

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"STAY IN FORMATION! WALK STRAIGHT! DON'T EMBARRASS ME!"

Small Business ignores him completely.

Micro-Manager sprints to catch up, lecturing the entire way down the ramp.

VALERIE VORTEX:

"Micro-Manager is already sweating and the match hasn't even started."

JIMMY V:

"He sweats when the wind blows, Valerie!"

? IN-RING MOMENT

Small Business climbs onto the apron and flexes like he's 6'5".

Micro-Manager tries to climb the steps but slips on the second one, catches himself, and pretends it didn't happen.

They enter the ring:

- Small Business points at Cyclone and GNOME!, shouting threats.
- Micro-Manager waves his clipboard like a shield.
- Cyclone looks ready to explode.
- GNOME! is staring at Micro-Manager like he's deciding which limb to bite first.

SCOTT:

"This is going to be a volatile Mini tag match -- and it's coming up right now!"

? COMMENTARY AS THE BELL RINGS

SCOTT COOPER:

"Mini Division tag action underway -- and look at Cyclone, he's ready to explode!"

JIMMY V:

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"GNOME! is licking the top rope, Scott! Why is he licking the top rope!"

VALERIE VORTEX:

"Psychological warfare. Or hunger. Hard to say."

? STARTING THE MATCH -- CYCLONE vs. MICRO-MANAGER

Micro-Manager insists on starting.

Small Business tries to stop him -- Micro-Manager shoves him aside.

Cyclone steps forward, eyes blazing.

Micro-Manager immediately regrets everything.

They lock up -- Cyclone launches him across the ring with a hip toss that sends the clipboard flying.

SCOTT:

"Cyclone with authority!"

Micro-Manager scrambles to the corner, screaming for a timeout.

There are no timeouts.

Cyclone drags him back to center and hits a running headbutt that sends Micro-Manager tumbling like a bowling pin.

? TAG TO SMALL BUSINESS

Small Business tags himself in, furious.

He charges Cyclone --

Cyclone ducks --

Cyclone hits a shoulder block that knocks Small Business flat.

Cyclone tags GNOME!.

The crowd pops.

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JIMMY V:

"Oh no. Oh NO. Here comes the gremlin!"

? GNOME! UNLEASHED

GNOME! scurries in on all fours, circles Small Business, then bites his boot.

Small Business hops around, yelling.

Willy D warns GNOME!

GNOME! hisses at him.

VALERIE:

"GNOME! is not concerned with rules. Or hygiene."

GNOME! hits a low dropkick to Small Business's knee, then a mini senton across the back.

Cover:

ONE!

TWO!

Kickout.

? SMALL BUSINESS TAKES CONTROL

Small Business catches GNOME! on a second senton attempt and hits a spinning slam.

He tags Micro-Manager, who immediately tries to pin GNOME! with one foot.

Cyclone storms in and kicks Micro-Manager so hard he flips backward.

Willy D tries to restore order -- fails.

SCOTT:

"This match is breaking down fast!"

? CYCLONE HOT TAG

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GNOME! crawls --

- Clothesline to Small Business
- Clothesline to Micro-Manager
- Double noggin-knocker
- Running splash on both in the corner

The crowd is on their feet.

JIMMY V:

"Cyclone is cleaning HOUSE!"

? FINISH SEQUENCE

Small Business shoves Micro-Manager forward as a shield.

Cyclone headbutts Micro-Manager, who collapses.

Small Business tries to roll Cyclone up --

Cyclone kicks out with force.

GNOME! jumps in and bites Small Business's hand again.

Willy D tries to separate them -- chaos everywhere.

Cyclone grabs Small Business, spins him, and hits the Cyclone Driver (Mini lifting DDT).

GNOME! tackles Micro-Manager to the floor to prevent the save.

Cyclone covers:

ONE!

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TWO!

THREE!

The bell rings.

? WINNERS: CYCLONE THE ANGRY DWARF & GNOME!

Cyclone raises the Mini World Title.

GNOME! raises Cyclone's arm -- Cyclone yanks it away.

GNOME! giggles and tries again.

Small Business rolls out clutching his jaw.

Micro-Manager crawls after him, reaching for his clipboard like it's life support.

SCOTT COOPER:

"A big win for the Mini World Champion and his... unpredictable partner!"

JIMMY V:

"GNOME! is trying to climb Cyclone like a tree! Someone stop him!"

VALERIE VORTEX:

"This division is chaos, but it's effective chaos."

Cassius Crown vs Liger Llama

? BACKSTAGE INTERVIEW -- "PRIME CUT" CASSIUS CROWN

(Regal Technician. Wrestling's Rightful King.)

Backstage.

Gold lighting.

Velvet-trimmed interview backdrop.

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Cassius Crown stands center frame, posture perfect, chin lifted, Mini World Title nowhere in sight because he doesn't need props -- he is the prop.

He adjusts his royal-blue cuffs as interviewer Renee Royale steps in.

RENEE ROYALE:

"Cassius Crown, tonight you face Liger Llama for the SWF World Championship. But earlier tonight, you were banned from ringside during G Money's match. Your thoughts?"

Cassius closes his eyes...

Exhales...

Smiles the kind of smile that makes people want to throw things.

? CASSIUS CROWN:

"Renee... banning me from ringside was not a punishment.

It was a courtesy."

He taps an imaginary crown onto his head.

"Because had I chosen to involve myself, Safari Jackson would not have merely lost his match -- he would have lost his opportunity to ever stand in the same ring as royalty again."

He straightens his posture.

"But tonight is not about Safari Jackson.

Tonight is not about G Money.

Tonight is not about The Consolidation, the Minis, or whatever other... creatures... have crawled across this program."

He leans closer to the camera.

"Tonight is about legacy."

? ON LIGER LLAMA

Cassius scoffs.

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"Liger Llama is a fine champion.

A spirited champion.

A... fuzzy champion."

He waves a hand dismissively.

"But he is not a rightful champion."

He taps his chest.

"I am the heir apparent.

The noble technician.

The man who elevates this sport simply by stepping between the ropes."

? THE PROMISE

Cassius adjusts his gloves.

"Tonight, the SWF World Championship returns to its rightful lineage.

Tonight, the coronation is complete.

Tonight... the llama is sheared."

He smirks.

"And the king ascends."

Cassius turns, coat swaying, and walks off with aristocratic precision.

? COMMENTARY REACTION (CUT BACK TO RINGSIDE)

SCOTT COOPER:

"Cassius Crown is as confident as ever heading into the Main Event."

JIMMY V:

"Confident? Scott, that man thinks he was born with a title belt!"

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VALERIE VORTEX:

"And if he wrestles as well as he talks, Liger Llama is in for a long night."

?? BACKSTAGE INTERVIEW -- LIGER LLAMA (SWF WORLD CHAMPION)

Backstage.

Simple black backdrop.

No theatrics.

Just the SWF World Champion standing tall, cape draped over his shoulders, mask gleaming under the lights.

He's calm.

Focused.

Breathing steady.

Renee Royale steps in beside him.

RENEE ROYALE:

"Liger Llama... tonight you defend the SWF World Championship against Cassius Crown -- a man who believes he is the rightful heir to the throne. Your response to his comments?"

Liger doesn't speak immediately.

He tilts his head -- that signature, deliberate motion.

Then he brings the mic to his lips.

? LIGER LLAMA:

"Cassius Crown talks about legacy...

He talks about lineage...

He talks about destiny."

He taps the center plate of the SWF World Title.

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"But this?

This isn't inherited.

This isn't handed down.

This is earned."

He steps closer to the camera.

"Cassius wants to call himself royalty?

Fine.

Let him wear his imaginary crown.

Let him polish his imaginary throne."

A pause.

"But tonight...

he steps into the ring with a man who doesn't need a crown to be king."

? ON THE FIRST EPISODE

Liger nods slowly.

"I remember the first episode of Sunday Night SLAM.

I remember watching Safari Jackson get robbed.

I remember watching Cassius take the shortcut."

He raises a finger.

"But shortcuts don't work against me."

? THE PROMISE

Liger lifts the SWF World Title onto his shoulder.

"Cassius Crown says he's going to shear the llama."

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A long, cold stare.

"Tonight...

he finds out llamas kick back."

He steps past Renee, stopping just long enough to deliver the final line over his shoulder:

"And when the dust settles...

the mask stays on...

and the crown stays mine."

Liger walks off -- calm, confident, ready.

? COMMENTARY REACTION (CUT TO RINGSIDE)

SCOTT COOPER:

"The champion looks laser-focused. No games. No distractions."

JIMMY V:

"Cassius might've talked himself into a beating tonight!"

VALERIE VORTEX:

"Two elite competitors. One championship. This is going to be special."

?? MAIN EVENT HYPE PACKAGE -- "THE CROWN AND THE MASK"

The screen fades to black.

A single heartbeat echoes.

Then--

BOOM.

A golden flash.

The SWF World Championship fills the screen.

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? NARRATOR (V.O.)

"In the Superstar Wrestling Federation...

opportunity is earned.

Championships are fought for.

Legacies are built... one match at a time."

? CASSIUS CROWN -- THE CHALLENGER

Clips roll:

- Cassius Crown defeating Safari Jackson on Episode 1.
- Cassius wrenching Safari's arm, hitting the Prime Time Elbow.
- Cassius standing over him, smirking.
- Cassius pointing to the World Title graphic.

CASSIUS CROWN (V.O.):

"I am the rightful heir.

The throne was always meant for me."

We see him training:

Perfect footwork.

Perfect technique.

Perfect arrogance.

? SAFARI JACKSON -- THE ROBBED CONTENDER

Clips flash:

- Safari hitting the Safari Splash.
- G Money dragging him out of the ring.

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- Safari crashing into the steps.

- Cassius stealing the pin.

SCOTT COOPER (V.O.):

"Safari Jackson had the match won... until G Money took it from him."

Safari slams his fists on the mat in frustration.

? LIGER LLAMA -- THE CHAMPION

The music shifts -- heroic, determined.

Clips roll:

- Liger Llama winning the SWF World Championship.

- Liger defending it against giants, technicians, brawlers.

- Liger standing tall, mask gleaming, belt raised high.

LIGER LLAMA (V.O.):

"I didn't inherit this.

I earned it."

We see him training:

Kicks.

Rolls.

Rope running.

A champion sharpening his edge.

? THE COLLISION COURSE

Split-screen:

Cassius Crown on the left -- cold, calculated, regal.

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Liger Llama on the right -- focused, intense, unshakable.

NARRATOR (V.O.):

"One man believes the crown is his destiny.

One man believes the mask is his identity."

Clips of their promos from earlier tonight:

- Cassius: "Tonight... the coronation is complete."

- Liger: "Champions don't fear challengers."

? THE FINAL STAKES

The screen flashes:

SWF WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP

ON THE LINE

TONIGHT

Crowd shots.

Fans holding signs:

"LLAMA NATION"

"CASSIUS IS KING"

"MASK > CROWN"

NARRATOR (V.O.):

"Two paths.

Two destinies.

One championship."

? FINAL MONTAGE

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Rapid-fire clips:

- Cassius hitting the Crown Breaker.
- Liger hitting the Llama Kick.
- Cassius locking in the Regal Stretch.
- Liger countering with a roll-through.
- Cassius pointing to the belt.
- Liger raising it.

The music swells.

?? TITLE CARD

LIGER LLAMA

VS.

CASSIUS CROWN

SWF WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP

MAIN EVENT

NEXT

? CUT BACK TO COMMENTARY

SCOTT COOPER:

"This is what it's all about! The SWF World Championship -- on the line!"

JIMMY V:

"Cassius says tonight is his coronation! Liger says llamas kick back! I say LET'S GO!"

VALERIE VORTEX:

"Two elite athletes. One title. No excuses."

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The arena lights dim to a deep gold and white glow.

The crowd buzzes -- that unmistakable electricity of a true Main Event.

SCOTT COOPER:

"This is what Sunday Night SLAM is all about. The World Championship. The biggest stage. The brightest lights."

JIMMY V:

"I've got goosebumps, Scott! This is THE match!"

VALERIE VORTEX:

"Two elite competitors. One title. No excuses."

The bell hasn't rung yet, but the tension is thick enough to cut with a knife.

? CASSIUS CROWN -- ALREADY IN THE RING

Cassius stands in his corner, robe draped over his shoulders, chin lifted, posture regal.

He doesn't look nervous.

He looks entitled.

He raises one hand to silence the crowd -- they boo louder.

Cassius smirks.

? LIGER LLAMA -- THE CHAMPION

Liger Llama stands in the opposite corner, mask gleaming, cape draped behind him, the SWF World Championship strapped proudly around his waist.

He doesn't move.

He doesn't blink.

He just stares at Cassius.

The crowd chants:

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"LLA-MA! LLA-MA! LLA-MA!"

? RING ANNOUNCER -- BIG MATCH VOICE

The ring announcer steps to center ring, microphone raised.

RING ANNOUNCER:

"Ladies and gentlemen...

this is your MAIN EVENT of the evening!"

Crowd roars.

"This match is scheduled for one fall...

and it is for the SWF WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP!"

Another explosion of cheers.

? INTRODUCING THE CHALLENGER

Spotlight hits Cassius Crown.

"Introducing first...

the challenger...

from the Crown District...

weighing in at 221 pounds...

he is The Regal Technician...

CASSIUS... CROWN!"

Cassius raises his arms like he's already won.

The boos rain down -- he soaks them in like applause.

JIMMY V:

"He's loving every second of this!"

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VALERIE:

"He believes this is his coronation."

? INTRODUCING THE CHAMPION

Spotlight shifts to Liger Llama.

"And his opponent...

from the Andes Heights...

weighing in at 213 pounds...

he is the reigning... defending...

SWF WORLD CHAMPION...

LIGER... LLAMA!"

The crowd ERUPTS.

Liger raises the title high with one arm -- calm, confident, unshaken.

Cassius glares at the belt like it's already his.

? THE FINAL MOMENT BEFORE WAR

The referee takes the SWF World Championship from Liger and holds it high for the entire arena to see.

SCOTT COOPER:

"That is what it's all about!"

The ref hands the belt to ringside.

Cassius steps forward.

Liger steps forward.

They stand nose-to-nose.

No words.

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No gestures.

Just pure, burning intensity.

The referee signals for the bell.

? THE BELL RINGS

The crowd is LOUD.

Cassius stands tall, chin lifted.

Liger crouches slightly, ready to explode.

SCOTT COOPER:

"This is it! The World Championship on the line!"

JIMMY V:

"Mask versus monarchy! Let's GO!"

? OPENING -- FEELING OUT, BUT TENSE

They circle.

Cassius extends a hand like he wants a gentleman's lockup.

Liger doesn't trust it -- but he accepts.

Cassius immediately tries to wrench the arm --

Liger rolls through, counters, and takes Cassius down with a clean arm drag.

Cassius pops up, embarrassed.

VALERIE VORTEX:

"Liger sending a message early -- he's not intimidated by Cassius's technique."

Cassius wipes his mouth, furious.

? CASSIUS TAKES CONTROL -- TECHNICAL DOMINANCE

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They lock up again -- this time Cassius transitions into:

- A wristlock
- A hammerlock
- A takedown
- A grounded chinlock

He grinds Liger down, forcing the champion to fight from underneath.

SCOTT:

"Cassius Crown is a master technician. He wants to slow this match down."

Liger fights to his feet --

Cassius transitions into a Regal Stretch attempt --

Liger scrambles to the ropes.

Cassius smirks.

He's in control.

? LIGER FIRES BACK -- SPEED AND STRIKES

Cassius charges --

Liger ducks --

Liger hits:

- A spinning back kick
- A running dropkick
- A flying forearm

Cassius rolls to the outside to regroup.

Liger hits the ropes --

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SUICIDE DIVE!

The crowd erupts.

JIMMY V:

"THE LLAMA IS FLYING!"

Liger throws Cassius back in and covers:

ONE!

TWO!

Kickout.

? MID-MATCH -- CASSIUS GETS NASTY

Cassius fakes a collar-and-elbow --

Thumb to the eye behind the ref's back.

The crowd boos.

Cassius hits:

- A kneeling neckbreaker

- A European uppercut

- A snap DDT

Cover:

ONE!

TWO!

Liger kicks out.

Cassius immediately transitions into a grounded headlock, wrenching the neck.

VALERIE:

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"Cassius is targeting the neck -- setting up for the Crown Breaker."

?? LIGER'S SECOND WIND

Cassius goes for a lariat --

Liger ducks --

Liger hits a springboard crossbody!

Both men down.

They rise at the same time --

Liger unleashes:

- Knife-edge chop

- Knife-edge chop

- Spinning heel kick

Cassius staggers.

Liger hits the ropes --

LLAMA KICK!

Cover:

ONE!

TWO!

THR-- NO! Cassius gets the shoulder up!

SCOTT:

"Liger was a heartbeat away from retaining!"

? CASSIUS'S LAST STAND

Cassius rolls to the apron.

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Liger reaches for him --

Cassius snaps Liger's neck across the top rope.

Cassius climbs the turnbuckle --

Diving knee drop to the back of the head!

Cover:

ONE!

TWO!

THR-- LIGER KICKS OUT!

Cassius pounds the mat in frustration.

He signals for the finish.

? FINISH SEQUENCE -- CHAMPIONSHIP DRAMA

Cassius lifts Liger for the Crown Breaker --

Liger slips out --

Roll-up!

ONE!

TWO!

Cassius reverses!

ONE!

TWO!

Liger reverses BACK!

ONE!

TWO!

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Cassius kicks out!

Both men scramble to their feet--

Cassius swings--

Liger ducks--

LLAMA KICK #2!

Cassius collapses.

Liger climbs the ropes.

The crowd rises.

SCOTT:

"He's going for it all!"

LLAMA SPLASH!

Cover:

ONE!

TWO!

THREE!

THE BELL RINGS.

? WINNER AND STILL SWF WORLD CHAMPION: LIGER LLAMA

The crowd ERUPTS.

Liger kneels, clutching the belt, breathing hard.

Cassius rolls to the ropes, stunned, furious, unable to accept the loss.

JIMMY V:

"The llama kicked BACK!"

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VALERIE:

"And Cassius Crown's coronation will have to wait!"

SCOTT:

"Liger Llama remains the face of the SWF!"

Liger climbs the turnbuckle, raising the SWF World Championship high as fireworks burst above the stage.

?? POST-MAIN EVENT -- THE CONSOLIDATION STRIKES

Liger Llama is still on one knee in the ring, clutching the SWF World Championship, breathing hard after surviving Cassius Crown.

The crowd is chanting:

"LLA-MA! LLA-MA! LLA-MA!"

He rises...

Raises the title...

And then--

? "Well... well... well..."

The camera WHIPS to the stage.

BIG BUSINESS steps through the curtain, standing just in front of the "Portal" stage entrance -- not magical, just the branded archway.

Suit immaculate.

Tie perfect.

Smirk lethal.

He brings a mic to his lips.

BIG BUSINESS:

"Congratulations... champ."

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The crowd boos HARD.

Big Business chuckles.

"You managed to squeak by Cassius Crown tonight...

but surely by now you've heard of the..."

He spreads his arms wide.

"...CONSOLIDATION."

The arena goes silent.

? AMBUSH FROM BEHIND

Liger turns--

DANTE VELLARO and BRUNO MARCHETTI slide into the ring from behind.

The crowd SCREAMS.

Liger swings--

Bruno catches him with a Sicilian Sledge clothesline that nearly decapitates him.

Dante pounces, raining down fists, Broadway robe half-torn, eyes wild.

Bruno drags Liger up--

Dante hits the Curtain Call knee strike.

Liger collapses.

? BIG BUSINESS LAUGHS FROM THE STAGE

Big Business doesn't move.

Doesn't blink.

Just watches his "Made Men" dismantle the World Champion.

?? THE FINAL IMAGE

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Dante and Bruno stand over Liger Llama:

- Arms raised
- Suits torn
- Sweat dripping
- Boots planted firmly on the champion's chest

The SWF World Championship lies beside Liger, inches from his hand.

Big Business points at the belt and laughs.

? FADE OUT -- CREDITS ROLL

The last shot:

The Consolidation standing tall.

The World Champion broken beneath them.

Big Business smiling like he owns the company.

The screen fades to black.
